4.	22	General : SCOPE OF WORK	We understand that Bidder's scope would be limited to supply and installation of the hardware and software (operating system) asked in the RFP. Application and other things would be taken care by Bank/their SI only.	Please refer the detailed scope in the RFP. it includes delivery of hardware, software, site for hosting, providing link, implementation of synchronous replication between DC and Near DR and asynchronous replication between DR and Near DR.
5.	26/4.3.6	In future, Bank may carry out design modification and/or application addition to the Bank network, including modification for the security policy implementation. Accordingly, vendor should carry out necessary configuration changes in the telecom network, as advised by the Bank time to time. Bank will only pay the cost of material changes. However, service provider will make the necessary non-material changes without any additional cost to the Bank.	Here we are providing pure P2P Ethernet circuit – hence no NW changes is required unless upgradation of BW, request UCO bank to share more details on the required changes applicable to NW	Clause stands as per RFP.
6.	26/4.3.9	All necessary connections required to terminate the link Assuming UCO will arrange required SFP if required shall be provided by the selected bidder.
