



Asking for Credit or Debit Card Issuance or Verification



Bevare

Fraudsters impersonating Bank, call victims for card issuance or verification, persuading them to share personal, sensitive or financial information to commit fraudulent activities.

Sometimes, in the name of verification of Cards, victims are redirected to fake websites mimicking Bank's Official website to enter personal, sensitive or financial information.

Fraudsters misuse these sensitive details to commit fraudulent activities like raising loans, making unauthorized transactions, changing of registered mbile number etc.

Cyber Safety Practices to Avoid Such Scams

- No not share sensitive or financial information like card number, PIN, CVV, OTP, UPI PIN etc. with anyone under any circumstances.
- Never click on links, visit websites & enter your personal, sensitive or financial details in ransom website.
- ✓ If unsolicited calls in the name of Bank is received, cross-check with Bank Branch through direct communication.
- Regularly monitor Bank account activities. If any unauthorized transaction is noticed, inform your Bank promptly.
- Enable multi-factor authentication (MFA) for online accounts & transactions.
- Report fraudulent calls, SMS or WhatsApp to CHAKSHU Portal at https:// sancharsaathi.gov.in.
- **V** Report cyber fraud incidents by dialling Helpline No. **1930** & lodge complaint at Cybercrime Reporting Portal https://cybercrime.gov.in.
